Trenton, MI – A Navy Rear Admiral will accept a special gift on Saturday on behalf of the men and women serving overseas when Trenton Forging delivers a total of 50 sets of The Patriot Game horseshoes, which will be given to U.S. military in Iraq and Afghanistan. Trenton Forging President David Moxlow will present the horseshoes to Rear Admiral Gordon Russell at Selfridge Air Force Base at 1 p.m. on Saturday.

“We appreciate all that our military men and women do to keep us safe,” Moxlow said. “They put their lives on the line daily to defend and protect our country. This is just a small token of our thanks. We hope that it will bring them some lighthearted moments to their demanding schedules.”
